

## Beaumont ACO quality corner

The Beaumont ACO is making a concerted effort to improve the Medicare Shared Savings Plan measure “All – Cause Unplanned Readmission for Patients with Multiple Chronic Conditions (ACO 38)”. Providers who are participating in Medicare Shared Savings Plan can assist in the following ways:

- Provide timely access into your office for beneficiaries following a hospitalization, emergency room visit, post skilled nursing discharge or request from the beneficiary for symptoms that are concerning the beneficiary.
- For beneficiaries that need additional support please refer these cases to the Advance Illness Management Team (AIM). This team is composed of a Nurse Practitioner and RNs that will connect with your beneficiary and their support systems to help stabilize their self-care in their home. - Beneficiaries that are identified as struggling with unplanned readmissions (ACO 38) will be noted on beneficiary lists that are presented at Medical Director meetings. These lists allow the provider to focus on these requested efforts to reduce unplanned readmissions.
