**John Kerndl** is executive vice president and chief financial officer at Beaumont Health, Michigan's largest health care system, based on inpatient admissions and net patient revenue.

In this role, Kerndl oversees all Beaumont financial functions, including reporting and analysis, revenue cycle operations, financial system and internal controls, accounts payable, payroll, treasury, budgeting and forecasting, project financing, financial strategic planning, strategic investments, investor relations and supply chain. He joined Beaumont in 2016, previously serving as senior vice president and operations CFO for LifePoint Health in Brentwood, Tennessee. He joined LifePoint in 2010 as CFO for what was then their largest division comprised of 11 hospitals in four states. From 2007 to 2010, he served in CFO and regional vice president-in-training roles for three Arizona hospitals as part of Vanguard Health Systems. Prior to that, he served as assistant CEO and CFO for Community Health Systems in Illinois.

Kerndl also worked for Tenet Healthcare Corporation as a CFO for North Shore Medical Center in Miami, and as a regional finance director in Atlanta, Georgia and Hilton Head, South Carolina. Earlier in his career, he was a practice administrator for Cone Health in Greensboro, North Carolina, and directed the operations of large medical groups in Florida and California.

Kerndl earned his Master of Business Administration in finance from the University of Chicago and his bachelor's degree in finance from Georgia State University.

Beaumont Health is a not-for-profit organization formed in 2014 by Beaumont Health System, Botsford Hospital and Oakwood Healthcare to provide patients and families with compassionate, extraordinary care, no matter where they live in Southeast Michigan. It consists of eight hospitals with 3,429 beds, 174 outpatient sites, nearly 5,000 physicians, 36,000 employees and 3,500 volunteers. In 2016, the organization had \$4.4 billion in net revenue with nearly 178,000 inpatient discharges, 568,000 emergency visits and more than 17,500 births.
