



2016 ANNUAL MEETING SUMMARY

Over 150 Oakwood ACO members attended the 2016 Annual Meeting of the Members. Dr. Abdallah, Chairman of the Board, and Dr. Shah, Vice Chairman, provided an overview of the achievements of Oakwood ACO during 2015. Board member elections were also held and results were announced (see page 2).

Annual Meeting Highlights

Maximizing Pay-for-Performance and Incentive Opportunities:

- **\$7.3 million dollars in incentive payments were distributed to ACO members in 2015**
- The largest portion of incentive payments, \$4.5 million came from performance in the Medicare Shared Savings Program (MSSP). Factors contributing to success were quality performance and reductions in admissions, SNF, ED and MRI utilization
- The Medicare Shared Savings Advanced Illness Management Services program was also launched in 2015. We encourage you to reach out to Vicki Kamal at (313) 586-5442 for support in treating your complexly ill patients
- **2015 BCBSM Physician Group Incentive Program (PGIP):**
 - **\$2.2 million in incentive payment distributions**
 - 321 participants, 117 PCPs and 204 specialists
 - 81 PCPs were designated for Patient-Centered Medical Home
 - 194 of 204 specialists received fee uplifts in 2015
 - 206 were nominated for 2016; results will be available shortly

Physician Engagement:

- Membership has grown to 1,024 physicians, including 318 Primary Care and 706 Specialists
- The Oakwood ACO offers members 18 payer contract options covering 38 lines of business, including 2 which are exclusive to ACO members
- Covered lives grew 4% from 114,500 in 2014 to 119,400 in 2015. Looking back to our first complete year, lives have grown by 44,000—a 58% increase!

Information Technology:

- Began receiving statewide admission, discharge and ED notifications for use in ACO care management processes
- Provided MSSP, BCN, and OHSCare performance analytics to more than 100 primary care physicians and their practice leadership
- In 2016, we will expand the statewide admit/discharge communication by forwarding this information directly to additional providers
