Did you Know?

- Dec. 31 was the last day to close and complete quality measures for PGIP and Medicare Shared Savings program.
- The MSSP chart audit of 2018 calendar year began on Wednesday, Jan. 9 and ends on Friday, March 22. Members of our ACO MSSP team will perform audits. Access to EMR, other than EPIC, will be requested. If access cannot be provided, the chart review at your office will be scheduled in February or March.
- Remember, quality measure auditing is required in order to obtain shared savings. The high priority measures are:
 - medication reconciliation
 - eye exam for DM
 - HTN controlled
 - mammography
 - colon cancer screening
 - pneumococcal vaccine
 - fall screening

Remember, several quality measures for BCBSM and MSSP can be closed if the patient reports specific details to the provider and it's documented in the patient's record.

These measures are:

- breast cancer screening
- colon cancer screening
- diabetes eye exam

Documentation must include the procedure or screening completed with the month, year and result. The location and name of provider is very helpful as well if you can obtain.
